	Ensure your hospital has signed a <u>Business Associate and Data Use Agreement (BA/DUA)</u> with The American College of Surgeons. If your center currently submits to the NTDB you should already have a BA/DUA on file.	
	Execute a TQIP Hospital Participation Agreement (this will be sent after you submit an ACS TQP Application).	
	Pay the annual Participation fee (invoice will be sent after you submit an ACS TQP Application).
